

Painting Workshop with Kent McCormack Information Sheet



An 8-week program, Saturdays 9.45am – 12.15pm

We provide:

- The workshop venue: Campbelltown ArtHouse, located at Brookside Cellars Community Arts Centre, 17 Moore Street, Tranmere SA 5073.
- An easel (adjustable for sitting or standing) and chairs are available for those who may prefer to work seated.
- Small jars and water as needed.
- Tuition – one-on-one in a small group (minimum of 6 and maximum of 10)
- Tea & coffee refreshments

Participants need to bring:

- A palette suitable for mixing paints or a disposable tear-off palette is also suitable.
- Palette knife to mix colours and clean palette.
- Brushes include a flat bristle from small to about an inch & a half wide.
- Pencil (2B or 4B).
- A2 paper sketchbook (essential), stretched canvas &/or canvas board &/or canvas paper pad are optional. Please ensure you have a backing board to support works on paper, along with masking tape.
- Odourless solvent in a small-lidded container to clean brushes if using oil paint.
- Your choice of acrylic or oil paint.
 - Beginners need to bring at minimum the primary colours i.e. black, white, red, blue, yellow and raw sienna, student quality or Series One.
 - Non-beginners may bring whatever colours they desire.
- Medium if working with oils, we recommend Art Spectrum No. 1 Medium.
- Cloths, rags &/or paper towels.
